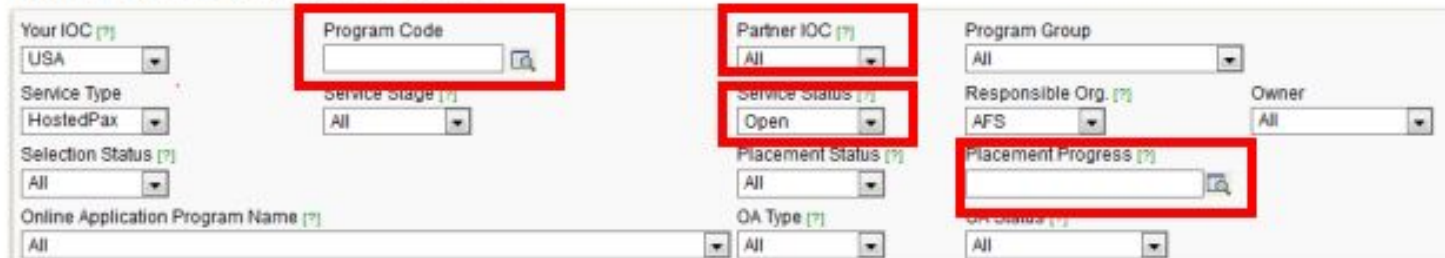
Searching for students and using filters

- From the search menu on the left, under 'Incoming Info from Partner', click on 'Hosted Participant'

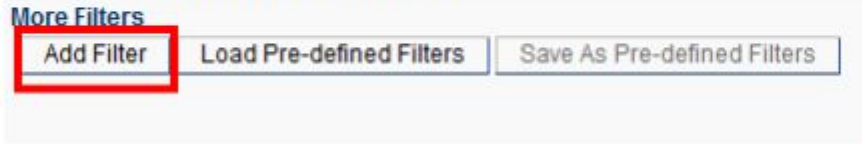

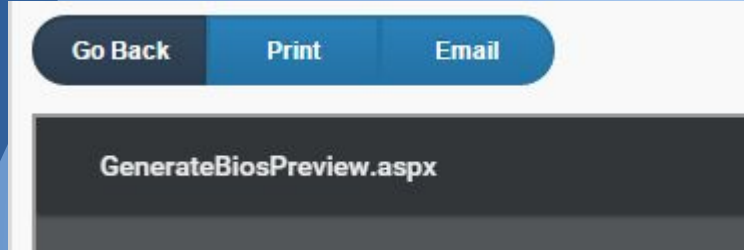
Letter to Host Family
