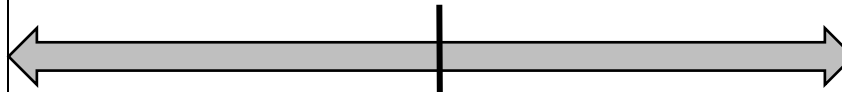


COMPARING VALUES - STATEMENTS

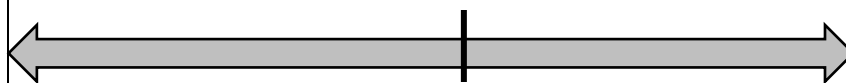

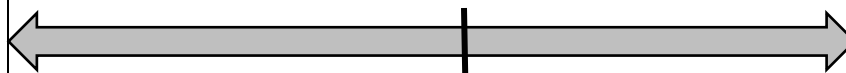

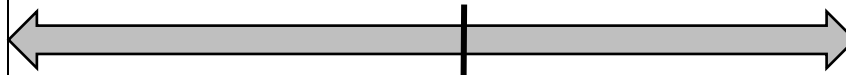
Cooperation is

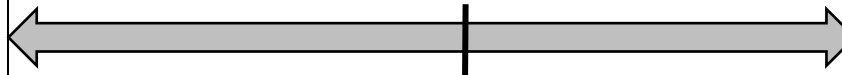

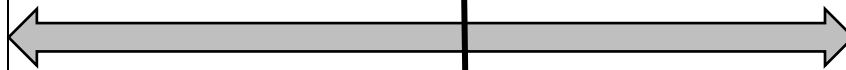
